Scavenger Hunt!

Directions: Five stations are set up around the room with photos of guitars from the Museum of Making Music. Each guitar you will find is different. Use the clues on your worksheet to find each guitar.

Clues:

1. Find a guitar made of nickel silver. If you look closely, you'll see three resonating cones inside. *Did you know...the cones work like megaphones and make the sound louder.*
2. Find a guitar made of wood with an extra arm, additional strings and a second sound hole. *Did you know...this guitar is called a "harp guitar" and the extra strings are called "floating strings." This extra arm helps to create more sound.*
3. Find a guitar that is made of graphite fiber. *Did you know...graphite fiber is a very strong but lightweight material and can give the guitar a bright and clear sound.*
4. Find a guitar that has sound holes shaped like the letter "f," similar to the violin or cello. *Did you know...these sound holes are called "F-holes." The guitar has a carved arched top which makes it louder.*
5. Find a guitar that has a round back. *Did you know...this back is made from Lyrachord, similar to what is used in helicopter rotors which makes this guitar sound louder.*
